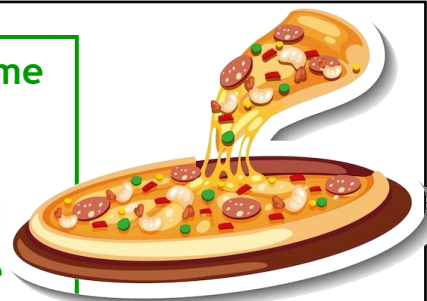


MISSION STATEMENT

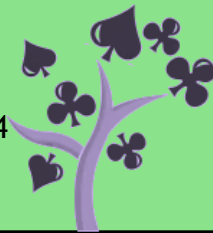


These are regular club games already scheduled throughout the year, but which will award **RED** and sometimes **GOLD** points.
