## Board 1

```
A 8
AQ6 53
KJ 9
K 52
```

The opponent opened 2 S . You have a really good hand and have to bid, else your side will miss game. In general you want

- 8+ points for a one level overcall (and a five card suit)
- 10+ points for a two level overcall (and a five card suit)

This is a three level overcall so you want a bit more, but with 17 points you can comfortably bid 3 H .

## Board 3

Partner opened 1 Spade. Opening bids promise 4+ cards in the suit.
You have three Spades, too few to raise Spades (you want at least 8 trumps between you).

But you have a good hand, so should either

- bid an immediate 3NT
- bid 2C. A new suit response at the two level shows 10+ points, so your partner must bid again


## Board 5

Partner opened 1NT (12-14). You have 9 points, so together there is not enough for game. You correctly passed.

## Board 6

You chose to lead a Diamond. Leading from a good suit like that (good means at least one honour in it) start with a low card (the 4). Leading a high card (the 9 of Diamonds) shows shortage in the suit.

Leading from a good suit with KJ973 will work well if partner has something in the suit, but will give declarer a cheap trick if partner has nothing. A safer lead is something like a Spade. If you were to lead Spades you would choose the 7, as you have nothing good in Spades.

Partner lead the Queen of Hearts. This must be from the top of a sequence (he had QJTxx). You correctly overtook with the King, so you could continue the suit with your nine.

Partner opened 1H. You have four card support so should raise Hearts.
When you have support for partner the scale is:
$2 \mathrm{H}-6-9$ points $\quad 3 \mathrm{H}-10-12$ points $\quad 4 \mathrm{H}-13+$ points
You have 15 here so should bid an immediate 4 H . If you only bid 2 H partner will think you are weak and may pass, missing an easy game.

## Board 17

You were declarer in 4H. It looks like you should lose 3 Clubs - but you threw away two of them on the extra $A Q$ of Spades.

(a) If you choose a Spade?
(b) If you choose a Heart?
(c) If you choose a Diamond?
(d) If you choose a Club?
3. The opponents open 1 H . What should you overcall with this hand?
4. Partner opens 1 H . What do you bid with this hand?
