Below are our updates for the month:

Operations

To minimise clashes with the APBF Congress and the Raffles Pairs on 18th May, we decided to move some events in the calendar. You can treat this calendar version as final except for inserting the Pesta Sukan Dates – please see page 6.

We sincerely apologise for any disruption in plans brought to our players and TDs.

Youth Development

As the JC1 intakes have been finalised, we have also finished our main engagement with various JCs on introducing Bridge to their mind sports / interactive games club. We are still waiting for some schools to inform us if there is sufficient interest to start a Bridge section in their club this year and will try again next year if we get a negative response.

While the level of student interest varies yearly, it is important to maintain strong relations with the JCs to build a continued presence and encourage a thriving Bridge club culture in the schools.

Club Relations

Policy & Guidance on Weekly Games @ SCBA

To promote a Safe Sport culture in the SCBA clubhouse, the Competition Secretaries and the President have decided to tentatively implement the following policy in SCBA from **1 Apr 2024**: *(Note: Purple text denote changes from the notice in Feb newsletter)*

1. (Weekly Social Games) No new boards are to be played with less than 4 minutes remaining in the round. All pairs are to be assigned an average for all unplayed boards, **without any further negotiation or expression of displeasure by any party.**

While we understand that several players want to play as many boards as possible, we cannot allow the entire session to be dragged on due to actions by a minority of players. This is especially compounded during evening games when both transport and safety for the senior players become an issue. At the same time, while it is possible in theory for Directors to ascertain the degree of responsibility by each pair for slow play, this discussion is unfruitful for the dynamics on the table and overwhelms the Director especially if he/she is also playing.

2. (All events) Players are **empowered to gently point out improper conduct** on the table to the offending party. They should call the director if the resolution is unsuccessful. The director should attempt to settle such cases within the session with no further rectification. However, if the incident is serious, this should be escalated to **SCBA's Safeguarding Officers (Amy, Raj).**

Improper conduct includes but is not limited to: (a) Commenting on the skill level of opponents on the table, **especially if they are weaker**; (b) Excessive provision of unsolicited advice to opponents; (c) Taking advantage of newer players by providing non-existent "table rules" or opportunistically calling the Director; (d) Calling the director for any minute break in tempo that most likely causes no UI; (e) Making weaker opponents feel at fault that they have been playing too slowly and do not belong in any weekly games; and (f) Any other behaviour that causes physical, emotional or psychological damage. Directors are to exercise professional judgment and common sense in determining the severity of each case.

We seek the understanding of the stronger players as we must protect the long-term interest of the sport. As SCBA is operating in a public, inter-generational environment, players are advised to be sensitive to cultural differences between each generation and be always mindful of their behavior in the clubhouse.

Donations to SCBA

**Enjoy a 250% deduction on taxable income by donating to SCBA.
Qualification for tax deduction is valid until 28 January 2027.**

Types of Tax Deductible Donations Available

1. Unrestricted donation to one of our three funds: General Fund, Bridge Development Fund, National Bridge League Fund
2. Restricted donation to set up a new fund for purposes dictated by the donor (SCBA will inform and seek the donor's opinion if the fund cannot be used)
3. Donations to name SCBA's events or programmes;
4. Donations where SCBA or its approved beneficiary acknowledges the donation by including the donor's name or logo in the SCBA's collaterals (e.g. banners, publications, advertisements). Examples would be Pesta Sukan Bridge Championships and future iterations of SEABCC and APBF if they are held in Singapore.

Claiming Tax Deductible Donations

Tax deduction is given for donations made in the preceding year. For example, if an individual makes a donation in 2023, tax deduction will be allowed in his tax assessment for the Year of Assessment (YA) 2024. The tax deductions for qualifying donations will be automatically reflected in the donor's tax assessments based on the information from the IPC (such as the donor's name, date and amount of donation on the tax deduction receipt).
