Looking over the Sunday Swiss Bridge

Our club offers a mix of in-person and online games, both in pairs and Swiss format. There are Swiss games other days of the week as well, but this article focuses on the past year of online Sunday Swiss games. Swiss games are 4-person teams, and the format for Sunday is 20 boards, 5 rounds. This format (short rounds) would be impossible to do in person (too much moving, too confusing) but is smooth sailing for the BBO platform.

Some of these Sunday Swiss games were regular games, and some were special games. We have the most regular games, but there are many other special games. This past year (10/11/23-9/29/24), we had regular games (18, 34%), online grand national teams (GNT) games (12, 22.6%), and online popup games (6,11.3%). Other games were North American Pairs (3), North American Pairs (4), Silver Linings (SL) (2), International Fund (1), Alzheimer's (1), Grass Roots (1), Stardust Week (1), Educational Fund (1), Junior Fund (1), Charity Week (1), and Club Appreciation (1). True, Swiss is not pairs, but ACBL allowed us to award extra points for that game.

Over this past year the table count for Sunday Swiss averaged 42 tables (average = 42.04), which is 168 fish in this pond. The largest game was 66 tables for a SL game on January 21, 2024. The smallest game was 18 tables for an online GNT game on December 24, 2023 (Christmas Eve). On average, the regular games were about the same size as the special games (40.44 versus 42.86). In the context of other online and in person games, Sunday Swiss game has thrived.

Regular games give black points. Special games give extra points (often doubled), or special colors (red, silver, gold), or both. ACBL caps the number of points for regular online games at 2.5, bumping that up to 5 for special online games, <u>no matter what the attendance</u>. At times, this rule can be frustrating. For example, even though they played 20 boards, the winners of the 66-table game earned only 5 points. If you want to complain about this cap, the person in charge of online games at ACBL is Lynn Chapin, lynn.chapin@acbl.org.

We would love to have you jump in with us in Sunday Swiss. The field is wide; there are big fish and little fish. The field is also stratified, which means that your team can win against teams that are about your level. You do not have to pre-register. 


