## Code of Conduct

All players are expected to abide by the following

Bridge is a game to be enjoyed; rudeness at the table is forbidden by the Laws of Contract Bridge.

#### THE DO's

At the start of each round greet other players and smile.

Volunteer the outline of your bidding system to them and forewarn them of any special calls by your partnership.

Congratulating the good play of your opponents is highly recommended.

Bid and play to time. Claim when you can, stating a line of play.

Accept rulings from the Director cheerfully, without arguing at the table. If you disagree with the Director, you are entitled to lodge an appeal before you leave.

Practise active ethics – when asked for an explanation, give full details of your partnership's agreement, both explicit and implicit.

#### THE DON'T's

Avoid lengthy post-mortems.

Don't give lessons to your partner or opponents at the table.

Avoid criticisms, especially of your partner.

Profanity, badgering, gloating and making insinuations are all unacceptable.

Don't give your own rulings at the table or of any queried results; always call the Director.

In summary, speak and behave at all times in a way that enhances the experience of the game for those around you.

Serious breaches will be referred to the Ethics Committee.

## Important Information for Players

#### **ALERT REGULATIONS**

Bridge is not a game of secrets – if you or your partner use a call that has an agreed meaning within your partnership then the opponents are entitled to know exactly what that bid means.

- Alerting is compulsory you can't ask opponents not to alert.
- You must alert all your agreements that the opponents may not understand, or may misinterpret. This includes:
  - Natural bids having an additional requirement
  - Weak jump responses eg Bergen raises, 2 over 1 responses, inverted minor raises
  - Fourth suit forcing
  - Multi 2D openings and responses
  - · Any bid that is rare or unusual
- You may ask your opponents about the calls that have been alerted when it is you turn to call. If you don't ask at that time, any subsequent questions, from you must be about the entire auction. You are not allowed to query the meaning of a single call.
- If you become declarer you should offer to give a full explanation of your auction to the opponents if it contains any alerted calls or calls that may not be fully understood (including self-alerted calls eg doubles).
- Self-alerting refers to the situation where a call, by its very nature, is regarded as having been automatically alerted. In this case an alert by partner is illegal. Some self-alerting calls include:
  - All doubles and redoubles.
  - Any 2C response to a 1NT opening
  - Suits previously bid by the opponents
  - All calls beyond the level of 3NT
- It is strongly recommended that before starting a round or match that you obtain the following information from your opponents:
  - Their basic system
  - The strength and style of their 1NT openings
  - Their carding agreements eg signals and discards

## Important Information for Players

#### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

- When you open 1C or 1NT your partner must announce to your opponents what the bid means, every time such an opening bid is made. This does not apply to a 1NT overcall.
- When you open 1NT your partner is required to announce the range e.g. 12-14 or 15-17.
- If you open 1C, your partner is required to announce its meaning e.g. at least 2 clubs.
- Failure to announce could result in an adjusted score, if the opponents are damaged.

#### **BEGINNERS LESSONS**

• Bridge in the Barossa will hold a six week beginners course on Tuesday afternoons and evenings from February 7<sup>th</sup> to March 14<sup>th</sup>. Further beginners lessons may be held during the year if there are sufficient numbers.

#### **BUDDY PROGRAM**

- Our club runs a buddy program to help beginner players gain confidence by playing with a more experienced player for up to 4 weeks. Novice players may call for assistance on bidding or play during normal sessions.

#### **LESSONS**

• Graham Harms offers lessons at 12.15 fortnightly before our Wednesday session. The topics to be covered are advertised in our monthly email updates.

#### **PIANOLA**

• Our club pays for Pianola membership for all its members. This enables individual results to be emailed to all players immediately after each session, showing all results and hand records. Pianola Plus, which our club also funds, allows you to re-play hands in order to improve your game.

#### **PARTNER FINDING**

• If you are in need of a partner, log into Pianola and use the Partner Finder function. This sends an email to all members.

## Important Information for Players

#### 'PSYCHIC' BIDDING

- 'Psychic' bidding is a term used in bridge to describe a bid which is significantly different from normal ranges. For instance, a player opens on 4 high card points or a 2-card major.
- Bridge in the Barossa does not permit psychic bidding in green masterpoint events, or in any event against players below the rank of National Master.
- If psychic bidding is used, it must be pre-alerted. Whether such bidding is a
  formally agreed part of a partnership agreement, or has developed more
  informally, all details of the practice must be listed, including the circumstances
  in which the bids may occur.

#### **Important Notes:**

- a psychic bid is only legitimate if it contains the same element of surprise for the psycher's partner as it does for the opponents
- systemic psyching of any kind is forbidden by the rules of bridge. You may not use a convention to signal a psyche to your partner
- you may not psyche a game forcing or near game forcing opening eg a 2 club opening
- frivolous psyching, suggesting you have lost interest in the competition or are enjoying yourself at the expense of others, is not permitted.

## **Online Bridge Opportunities**

There are many different programs available for playing bridge online when normal bridge clubs are unavailable.

- **Stepbridge** runs sessions every day for all levels of players. It is an Australian program which many find friendlier than BBO. It offers Australian masterpoints.
- **Bridge Base Online** is an American program. It is very popular and easy to use, and also offers casual "rooms" where friends can play together.
- **Real Bridge** is a British program, which offers a more realistic bridge experience. Players can see each other and speak to each other, but you need a fast internet connection. The ABF is beginning to hold national tournaments on this program.
