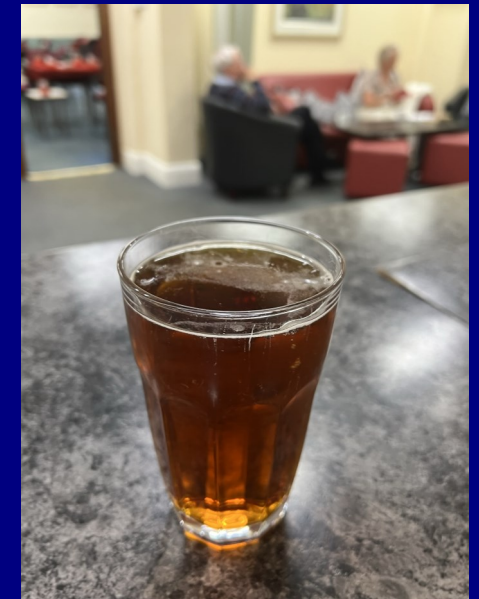

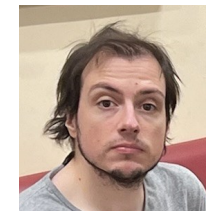
Our Directors

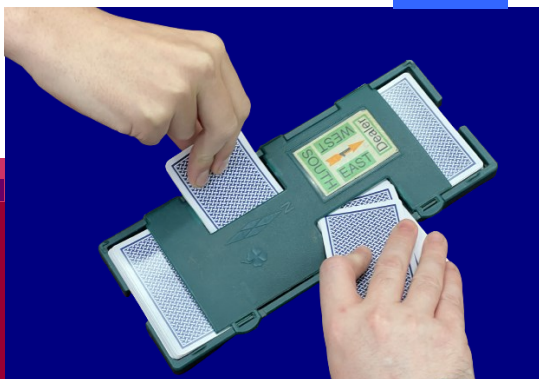


Courses and Masterclasses

At Bristol Bridge we aim to offer teaching to players of all abilities, from novice players who are taking up the game for the first time, through to experienced club players looking to incorporate new conventions and cardplay techniques into their game.

Courses are the foundation, aimed at players who are looking to learn the game, to build up a range of skills and knowledge over a number of weekly sessions.

We currently offer four different courses, the Beginner Course for those new to the game, the Refresher Course for those returning to the game, and the two Intermediate Courses for players who want to round out their skills. You can find more details about each course over the next few pages.



Where do I Start?

Our Beginner Course is designed for new players, or those returning to the game after a long time away.

If you are returning and can remember bits and pieces, our Refresher Course may be exactly what you are looking for. It covers the same topics as the Beginner Course but in a bit more depth.

Beginner Course

The Beginner Course is aimed at players completely new to bridge and card games. We start from the basics of the game and each week build up skills across a range of topics.

The course lasts ten weeks, and costs £70 for all sessions, or £90 for all sessions and a copy of the book *Beginning Bridge*. Alternatively the sessions are £8 each.

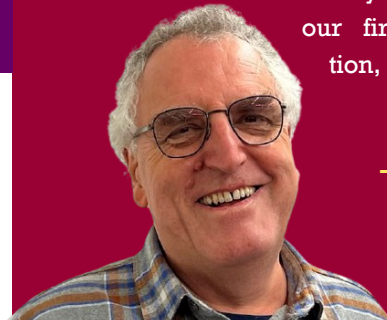

Course Details

Our Beginners course begins by introducing Mini Bridge, a slightly simpler version of bridge to introduce the main concepts of the game, such as tricks, trumps, dummy and declarer.

We then introduce the auction, and go through the basics of bidding, declarer play and defence before finishing the course by introducing our first convention, Stayman.

Refresher Course



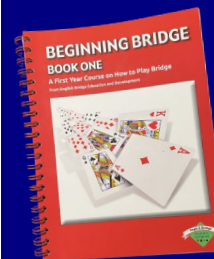

The Refresher Course is perfect for those who have spent some time away from the game and want a refresh on the basics, or players who have completed the Beginners Course who want to grow their confidence before moving to the Intermediate Courses.

As all our courses, it lasts ten weeks and costs £70 for all sessions, or £90 for all sessions and a copy of the book *Beginning Bridge*. Alternatively the sessions are £8 each.

This course uses the same book as our Beginner Course and covers similar topic but in more depth, as well as introducing a few new topics.

We also offer two Intermediate Courses, on Cardplay and Bidding when you are ready to continue learning! (Page 16-17)

Our Helper Duplicate on Mondays is the perfect introduction to duplicate sessions. (Page 24)

Intermediate Bidding Course

We offer two intermediate courses, one focusing on the bidding and one on the play.

In our bidding course we look at competitive auctions in more detail, covering overcalls, doubles and cuebids and how to handle them when your opponents use them.

The second half of the course looks at weak two level openings, transfers over 1NT, and Slam bidding.

Building up both a library of different plans to choose from and our ability to implement that plan effectively.

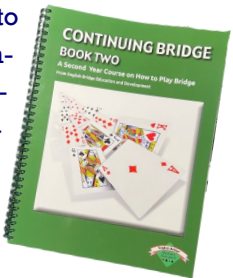

Defending Together

Defence is the hardest part of the game.

By learning how to communicate with our partner by giving signals, and understanding why partner may have made a particular play we can make it easier.

In the first session of this course we will look at the common signalling methods used and when to use each one.

The second session focuses on examining partners choice, deducing what they are trying to achieve and when it is right to stick with partners plan, and when it works better to pursue a different defence.



Avoidance Play

The most spectacular plays in bridge revolve around avoidance play.

In the first session we refresh ourselves on the core concepts of avoidance play, danger hands and safe hands, and how we can identify them.

In the second session we look at a range of clever ways we can keep the danger hand from gaining the lead.

The final session looks at the other side of avoidance play and how to try and defend against it. Again focusing on recognising the situation and finding ways to manipulate it to our advantage.

These sessions are run by one of our qualified directors (meet them all over on page 9), who will set everything up for game and are on hand to resolve any issues that may arise during the play.

Our premier level session, the club duplicate, is very similar to our relaxed duplicates, but with a slightly faster pace of play. We'll usually play 28 boards in three and a quarter hours.

These sessions are aimed towards our more experienced players, if you want to test your mettle against some of our stronger members come along on a Tuesday evening!



Helper Duplicate

On Monday evenings we have a helper duplicate. This is like a cross between a relaxed duplicate and an Ask an Expert session.

Just like in a duplicate you'll move around and play against different players, but Terry and David are both on hand to offer advice and to answer any questions you might have when you're unsure what to do!



This is a great session to introduce yourself to duplicate bridge! You don't even need to bring a partner, you can just turn up and you are guaranteed a game!



Which Sessions Are Right For You?

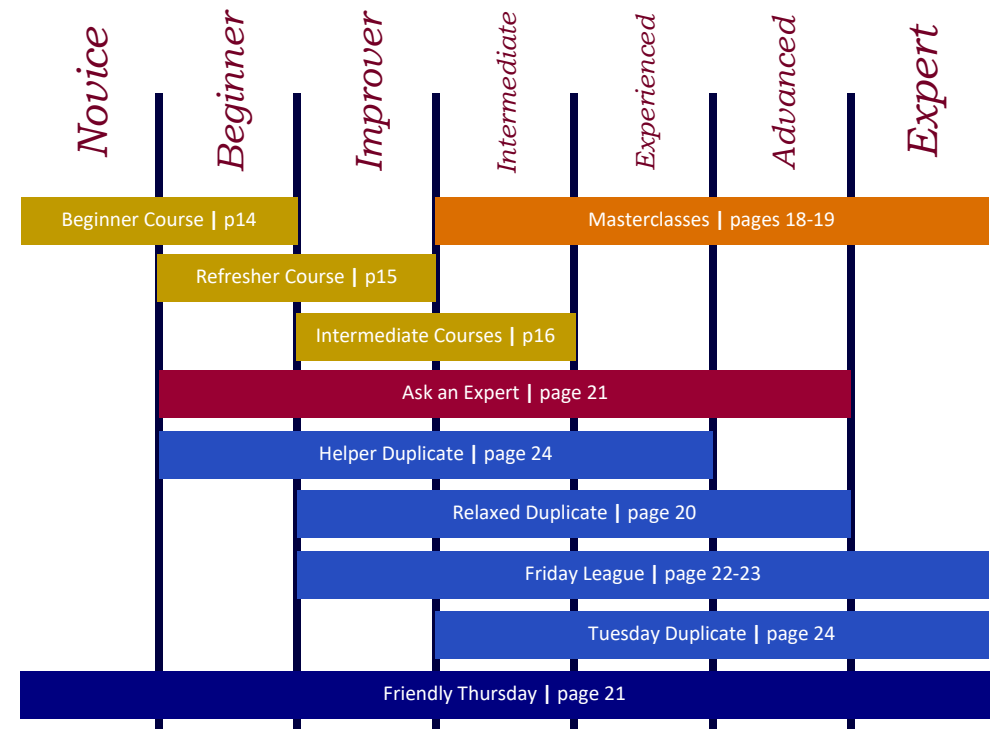
With all the different sessions out available it can be difficult to know which ones are right for you, but we are here to help!
